We have rooms blocked under "ACBS Winter Board Meeting" at the special negotiated rate of \$127/night plus 11% sales tax. The resort has waived their customary 16% resort fee for us. A small room has been reserved for the Executive Committee Wednesday afternoon. The full board meeting begins at 9:00AM Thursday. Please make your hotel reservations as soon as possible.

The Closest major airport is Orlando International (OIA). All major airlines have frequent flights into OIA. Alternative is Sanford-Orlando International, primarily charter carriers, but Allegiant and Sun Country have scheduled service. Travel time from both airports to the Mission Inn is approximately one hour. For your return flights, I suggest arriving at the airport at least an hour and a half before your departure time. OIA in particular can get very busy this time of year, resulting in long lines through security.

ACBS will cover the cost of breakfast and lunch for board members on Thursday. All other meals are on your own. The Mission Inn has two restaurants, one fine dining and the other more casual. There are also many restaurants within a twenty minute drive of the resort.

This meeting is in conjunction with the Sunnyland Chapter Antique and Classic Boat Festival. You and your guest will be provided with a badge that will allow access to the show site Friday and Saturday during the day at no charge. Sunnyland has also invited all board members to attend their Thursday evening volunteer reception at the Key West resort adjacent to the show site in Tavares, about a ten minute drive from the Mission Inn. However, if you plan to bring a boat to the show and/or wish to participate in any of the paid events you will need to register for the show and pay on line at the Sunnyland website www.acbs-sunnyland.org.
