Welcome all SoCal ACBS members, new and old. It's that time of year again when we get to have fun at one of our favorite places, **Bass Lake**.

Not only is this the first chance we have to get out and go boating with other wooden boat lovers but this is the only gathering of the Southern California and Northern California/Lake Tahoe Chapter memberships together. This marks the 28th year we will meet at Bass Lake.

Bass Lake is located approximately 54 miles North East of Fresno, just 3 miles from the town of Oakhurst. The Southern entrance to Yosemite is just another 20 miles up Highway 41. The lake is at an elevation of 3,400 feet, is currently owned by Pacific Gas and Electric and is considered a "warm water" lake.

The show will be held at The Pines Resort Docks, on the cement docks. The marina owner, Tommy, has consented to let us use these docks and will relocate his rental boats to another location.
