A general guideline for wooden boats to be considered “Preserved” is the retention of at least 65% of the original planks, not considering the bottom (which is to be excluded from the originality determination). Other hull materials should follow similar rules. Owner’s categorization will be accepted unless the judges find cause to determine otherwise, in which case the Chief Judge’s determination will be final.

This statement certifies that I am the owner of the above listed boat and that if the boat is launched in the water that the boat and the operator conforms to all state and federal laws and regulations. I am entering it in the 2018 **Vintage Treasures** Boat Show sponsored by the Southern New England Chapter, Inc of the Antique and Classic Boat Society, Inc. This event will take place at the Connecticut River Museum in Essex, Connecticut on **Saturday**, July 14, 2018. Pre and post dockage will be available from noon on July 13, 2018 until 4:00 P.M. and on July 14, 2018 from 7:30 a.m. It is required that the drivers of any launched boat, participating in our boat show, obey all local speed limits and safety ordinances while operating the craft in and around the docking area.

Owners who are having their boat judged are encouraged to be present while their boat is being judged. By registering a boat to be judged, the owner explicitly grants permission for the judges to board the boat as may be needed to properly judge the boat. Judges are experienced in these matters and take due care during the judging process, however, the owner agrees that neither the judges nor the sponsoring organizations nor the ACBS are liable for any damage that may occur during the judging process.

Further, I certify that I currently have effective insurance to cover any damage to my boat and to cover my liability for any damages to others, or their property, arising from any use of my boat, car, truck and trailer during this event.
