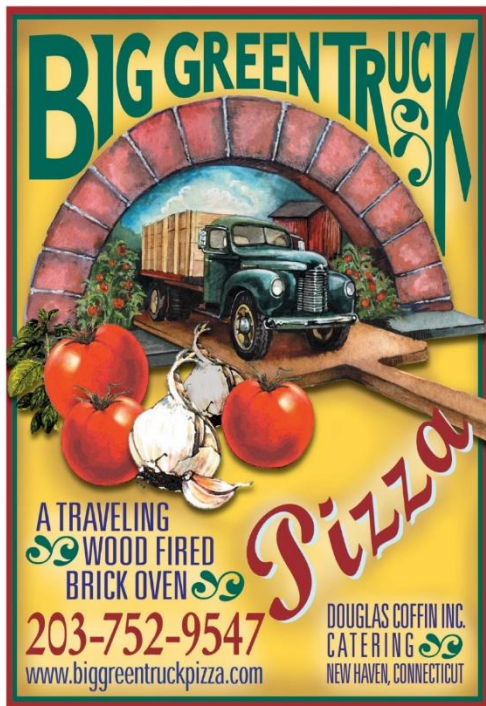

Look Who's Coming to the Southern New England Chapter Boat Show!

The *Big Green Truck Pizza* will be **on site** for our Friday July 13, 2018 dinner at the Connecticut River Museum!

They will be serving a wide variety of pizzas, buffet style, accompanied by a simple mixed green salad, espresso and cappuccino and six flavors of gelato for dessert.

Big Green Truck Pizza does thin crust, New Haven-style pizza. Their dough is simple (water, flour, salt, yeast – no added fats, dairy or sugar) and they use the best whole milk mozzarella and imported Pecorino Romano cheeses. The sauce is simple crushed tomatoes. They go light on everything therefore you can sample more pies! The dough is hand stretched at the event and baked in their high-heat, wood fired ovens with the end product having the characteristic charring around the edges.

The pies that they can make are endless – you can sample as many as you would like!

Cost for the Friday night July 13th dinner is \$19.00 per person.

Be An Explorer!

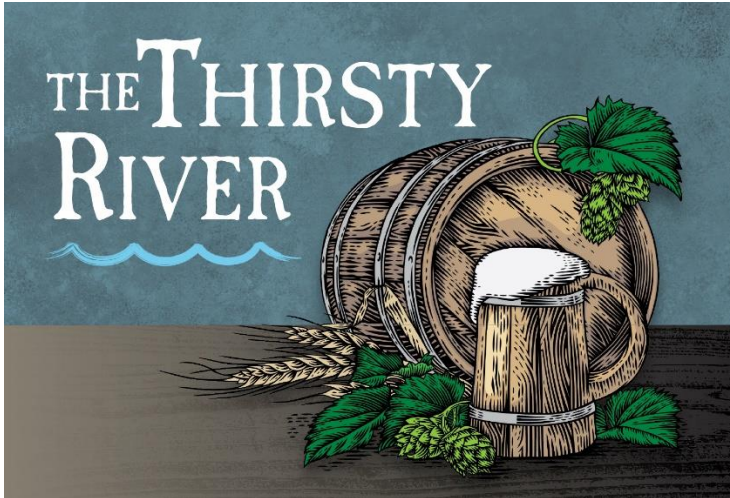

Thirsty River: 400 Years of Drink, Life and Reform in the Connecticut River Valley

Experience (or rather taste) the Connecticut River Museum's unique summer exhibit – **Thirsty River: 400 Years of Drink, Life and Reform in the Connecticut River Valley**. From colonial settlement to present day, alcohol has played a significant social, economic and political role in the Valley. The exhibit explores this complex history that is as dark as it is spirituous and as historic as it is relevant to today. Discover the stories behind the region's cider, beer, rum and other beverages. Explore how it impacted and shaped life. Hear tales of prohibition and rum running! And, uncover the nearly 80 breweries, distilleries, vineyards and cider mills in River towns today.

Special on Friday night July 13th, enjoy the **Hogo Rum Bar** within the exhibit. This bar features rare and specialty rums. Enjoy one of the house special mixed drinks or try an unusual rum – or a flight while you are at it! The bar is run by **Steve Gencarella**, the Museum's Resident Folklorist, a professor at the University of Massachusetts, and co-host of the popular ICRV Radio show *Fermented*. Be sure to ask Steve about the exhibit and the tales behind the rums!

Prices are \$6.00 to \$15.00 depending on the drink and flight.

The exhibit on the 3rd floor of the museum as well as the *Hogo Rum Bar* will be open on Friday July 13th from 4:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. for SNEC Boat Show participants.
